In September of 2016, specialists from the Seattle Aircraft Evaluation Group (AEG) completed an evaluation of the Aeronautical Application (AeroApp), version 1.1608.11, hosted on an Apple iPad and iPad mini. In addition, the AEG consulted with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Flight Inspection Services who are familiar with the application.

AeroApp is a collaborative effort reaching across NGA and other government agencies, focused on supporting the WarFighter and NGA Vision. AeroApp is designed to enhance the use of aeronautical Flight Information Publication (FLIP) data and manage individual FLIP products. We find the iOS Aeronautical Application to be operationally suitable.

The above determination of operational suitability does not relieve the requirement for operators to seek authorization to use this application and any corresponding hardware. Operational approval must be approved through the responsible FAA Certificate Holders District Office (CHDO). Guidance for evaluating specific mounting, EFB and software applications can be found in FAA Order 8900.1, Volume 4, Chapter 15 and Advisory Circular 120-76.
